This new edition of Applied Theatre will encourage students and practitioners to acquire a deeper understanding of the field and its best practices. The second edition of Jack Crumley's An Introduction to Epistemology strikes a balance between the many issues that engage contemporary epistemologists and the contributions of the major historical figures.
